OREGON CITY -- **Redside Development** will be recognized Friday with a BRAG (Business Recycling Awards Group) award from the Clackamas County Recycling Partnership for excellence in recycling, waste prevention and sustainable operations.

BRAG memberships go to businesses that recycle all relevant materials regularly, prevent waste with at least three ongoing activities, consistently buy recycled-content products, and demonstrate an on-going commitment to sustainable operations.

Redside Development, located in Suite 220 at 221 Molalla Ave., builds, operates and maintains energy efficient, low-impact buildings. The company recycles 95 percent of its construction and debris waste, replaces turf on its properties with more sustainable landscaping, and recently added a Sustainability and Social Responsibility Policy to its employee handbook. They use green cleaning products and work with vendors to minimize waste, emphasize the use of local materials and equipment, and recycle content products.
